

Discover the riches of Autun's medieval and Gallo-Roman heritage with your family, colleagues, friends or classmates by solving puzzles and challenging yourself!

10.30am - 12.00pm: City game 'La Pierre du Savoir' (The Stone of Knowledge) in Autun

Equipped with your adventurer's kit and in teams of 2 to 5 people, set off on an assault on the medieval quarter. Your mission? Find the hidden Stone of Knowledge. From riddles to puzzles, your discovery of the town will be full of twists and turns.

12.15pm: Lunch at the restaurant in Autun

Discover local specialities** in a convivial atmosphere.

2.30pm - 5.00pm: Unusual training activity in Autun

Set off on an adventure to discover the Gallo-Roman cultural heritage of the town of Autun from a new angle. Here's an example of the program:

1) Discover the circuit by running or walking according to preference (8km in total): start from the Roman theatre and go down to the Temple of Janus, passing through the two Gallo-Roman gates. There will be breaks to explain the history of Autun in Gallo-Roman times.

2) Return to the Roman theatre for a training session worthy of a Roman gladiator.

3) Local produce tasting (Les confituriers du Morvan, beer from the Brasserie du Morvan, etc.).

12.30pm: Lunch at La Crémaillère restaurant in La Boulaye


At this emblematic establishment in La Boulaye region, enjoy homemade dishes made from fresh seasonal produce**.

Admire the jewels of this Buddhist centre, founded by a Tibetan lama and whose architecture is reminiscent of Himalayan temples with its superb interior frescoes. Built on three levels, it houses gigantic statues of Buddhas and a host of colourful paintings. Completing 30 years of exemplary restoration work, the Treasury brings together the major works that have adorned the cathedral over the centuries (liturgical instruments, silverware, paintings, etc.). Upstairs, the chapter house displays the 12th-century historiated capitals attributed to Gislebertus, among the masterpieces of Burgundian Romanesque art.



LAPIDARY MUSEUM



Immerse yourself in the heart of the Himalayas! This temple of a thousand Buddhas was actually built in Burgundy. Calm, serenity and rejuvenation guaranteed.

MONASTERY OF BETHLEHEM - VAL SAINT-BENOÎT

Founded by the Lord of Sully in 1236, this priory was abandoned in the early 17th century. The 13th-century church and 15th-century chapel were listed as historic monuments in 1926, and have been restored since the arrival of the nuns.




